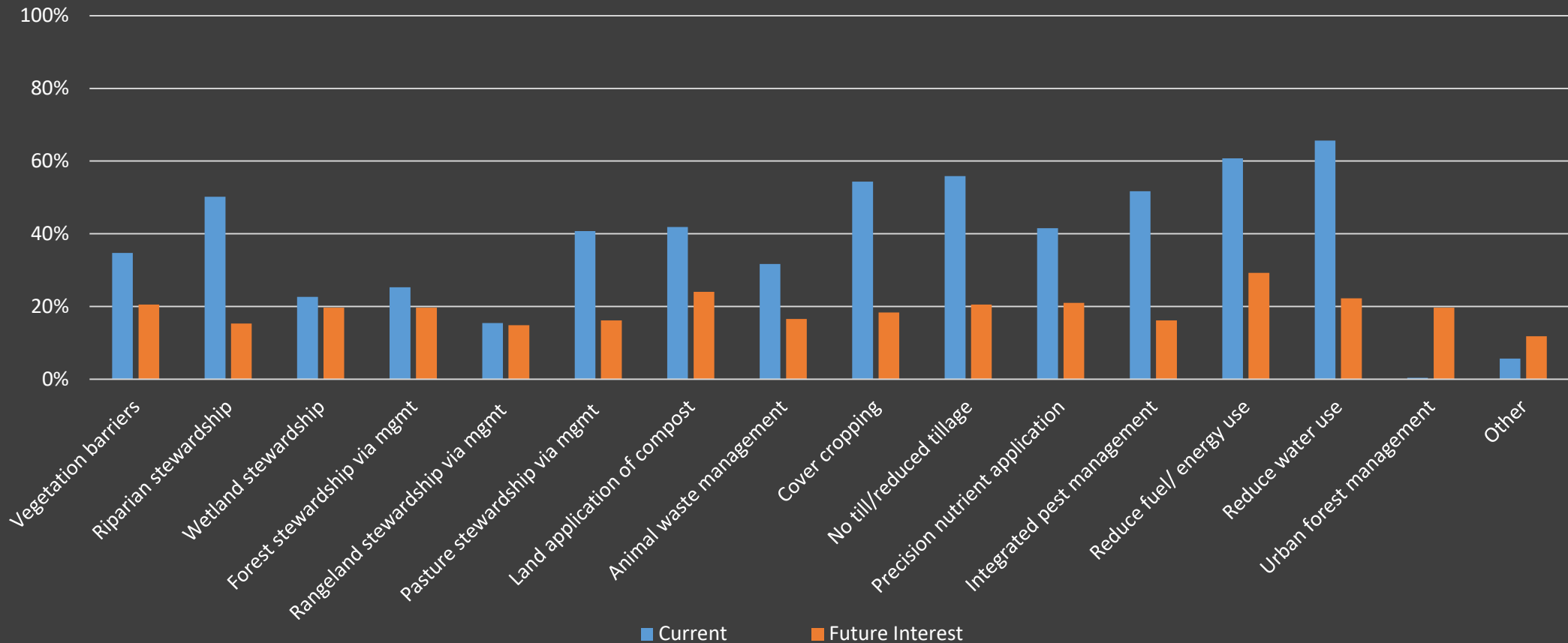
# Preliminary Results

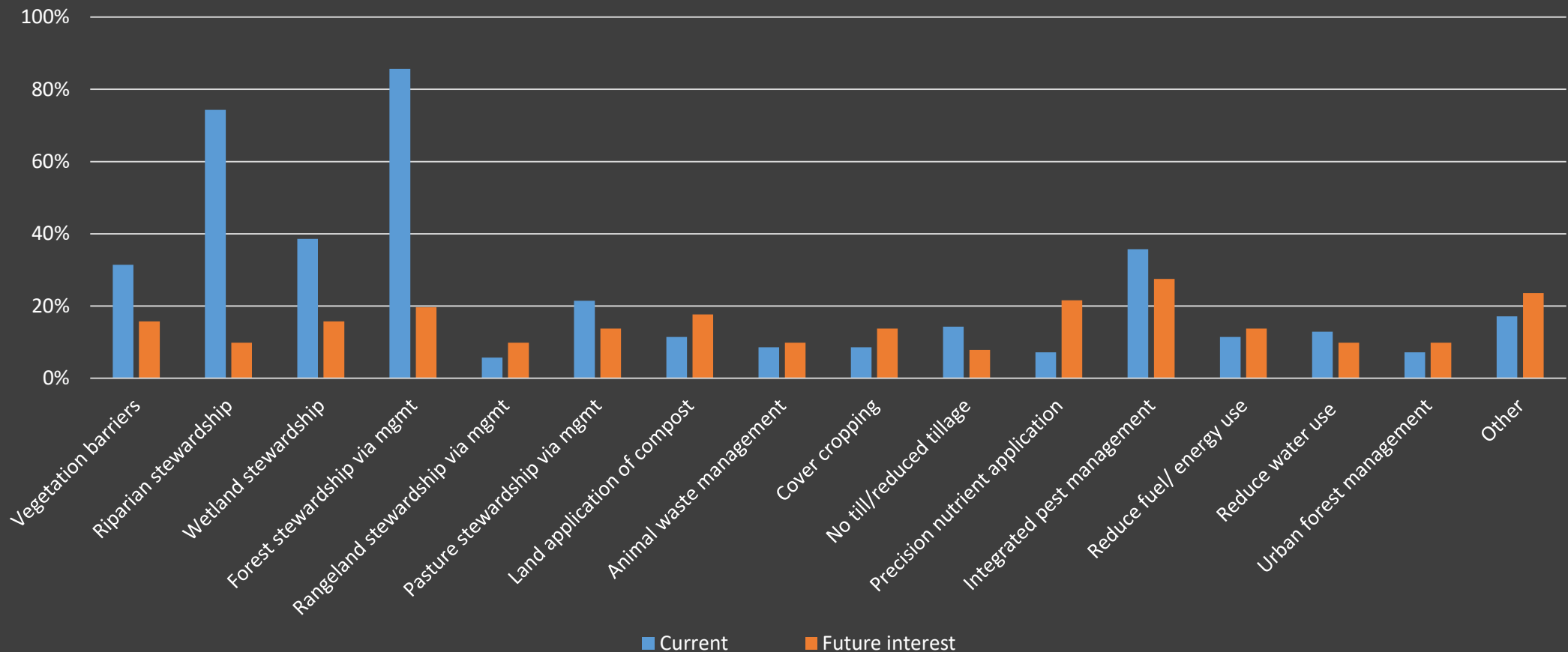
- ❖ Total responses received: 737

# Current conservation practices and future interest: Agriculture

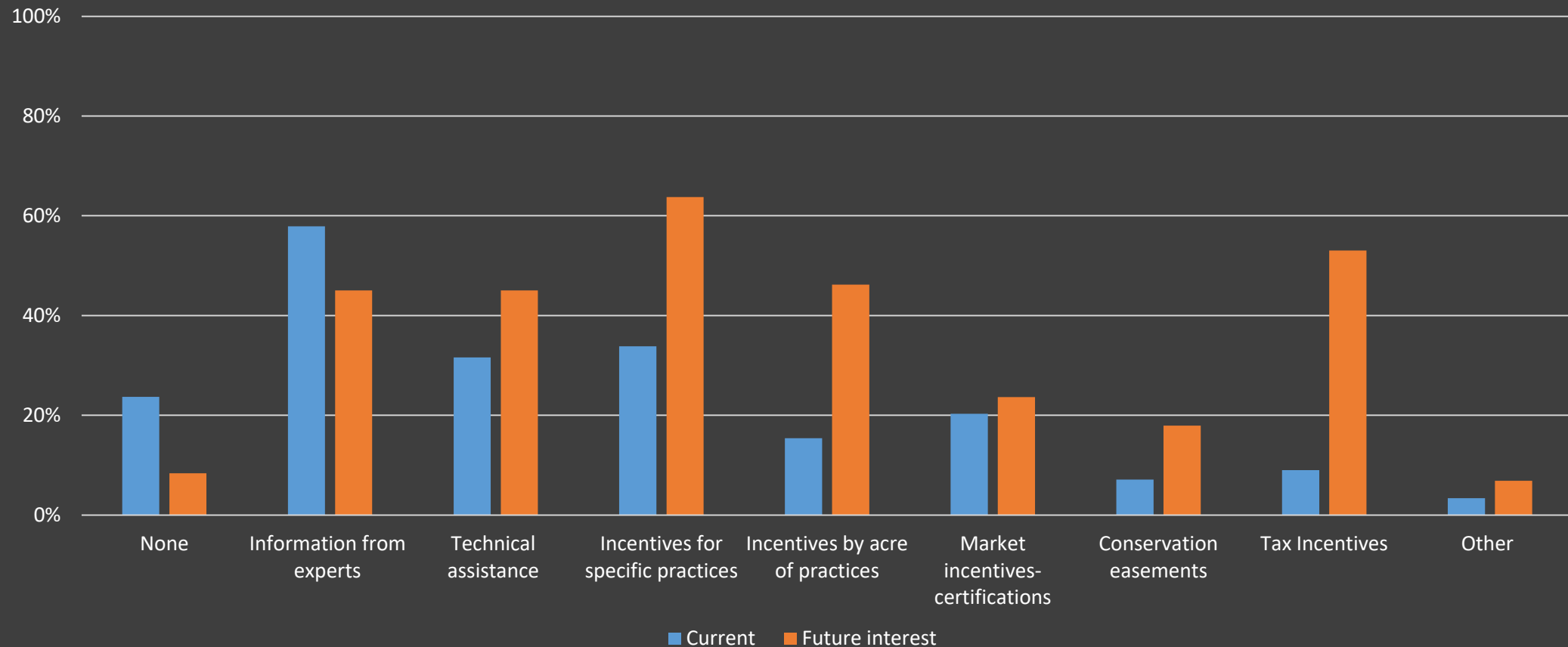


# Current conservation practices and future interest: Timber

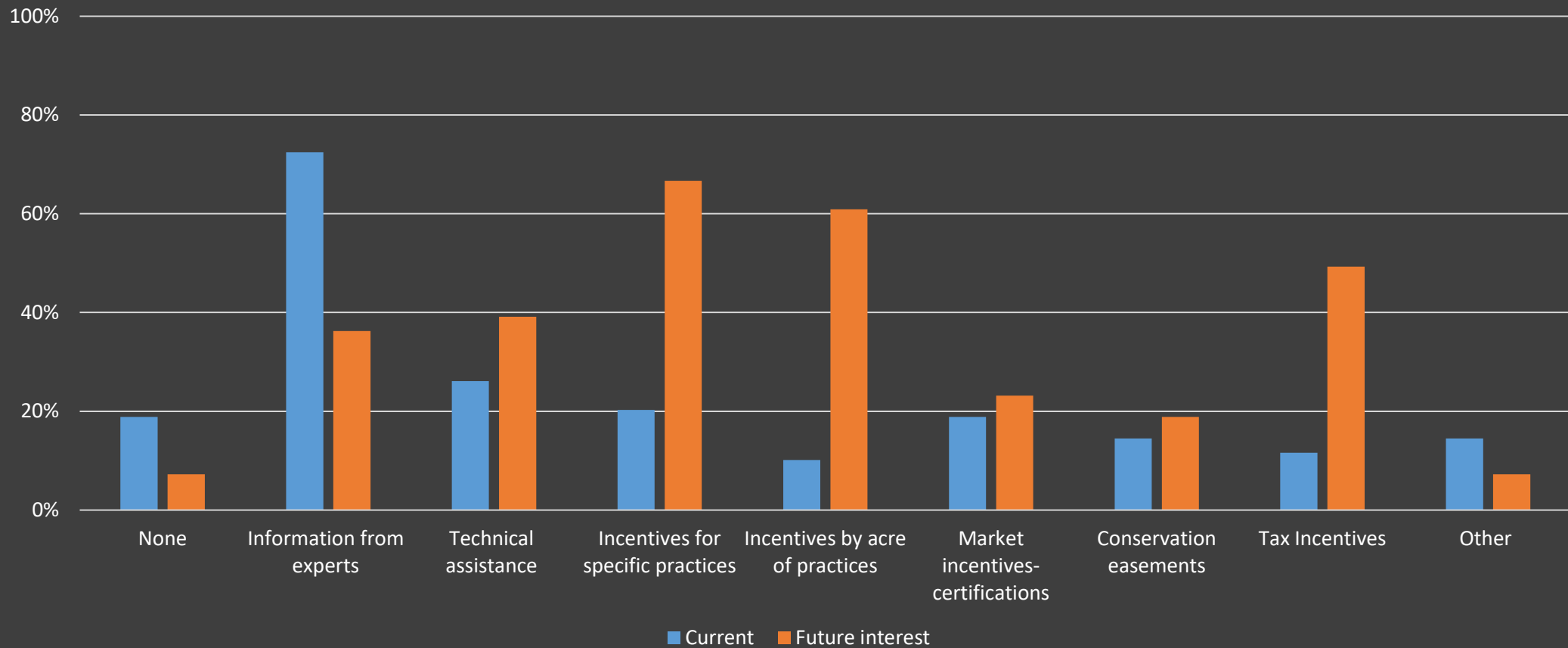




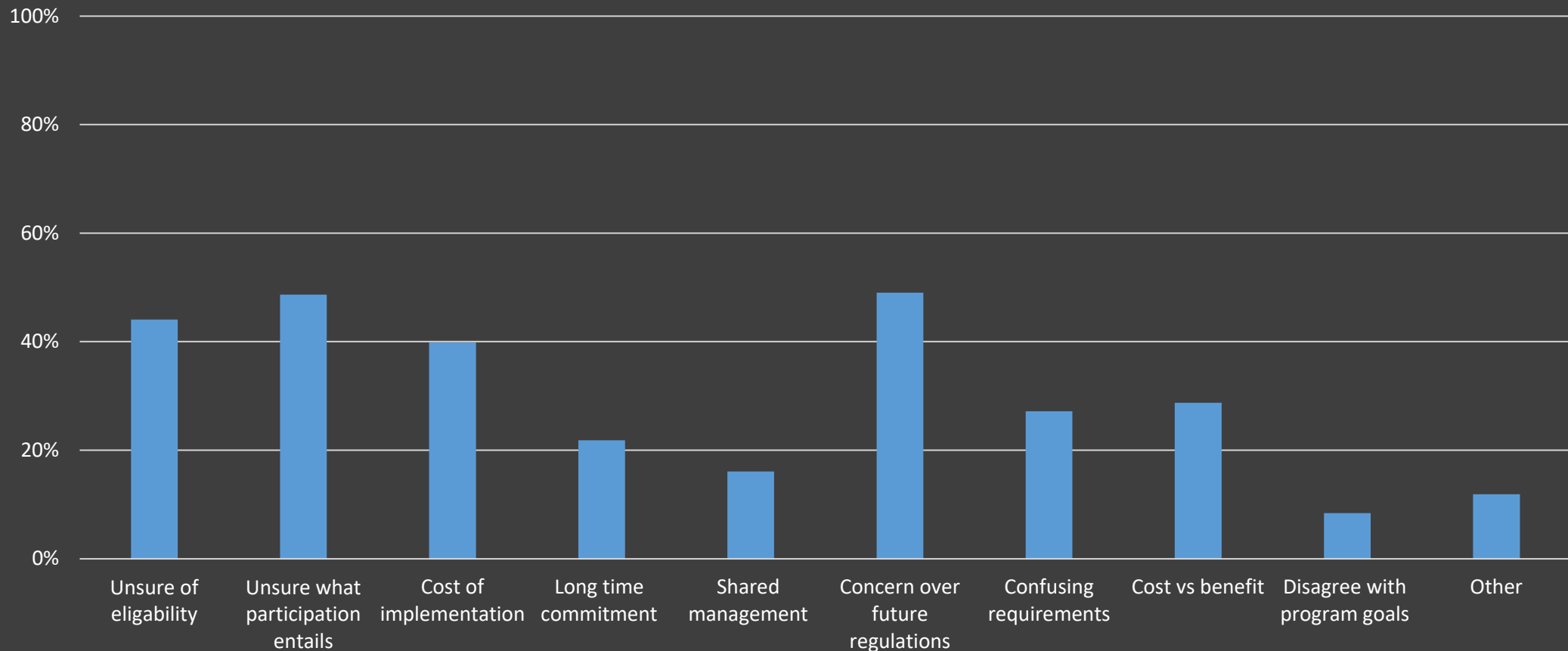
# Current incentives utilized and future interest: Agriculture



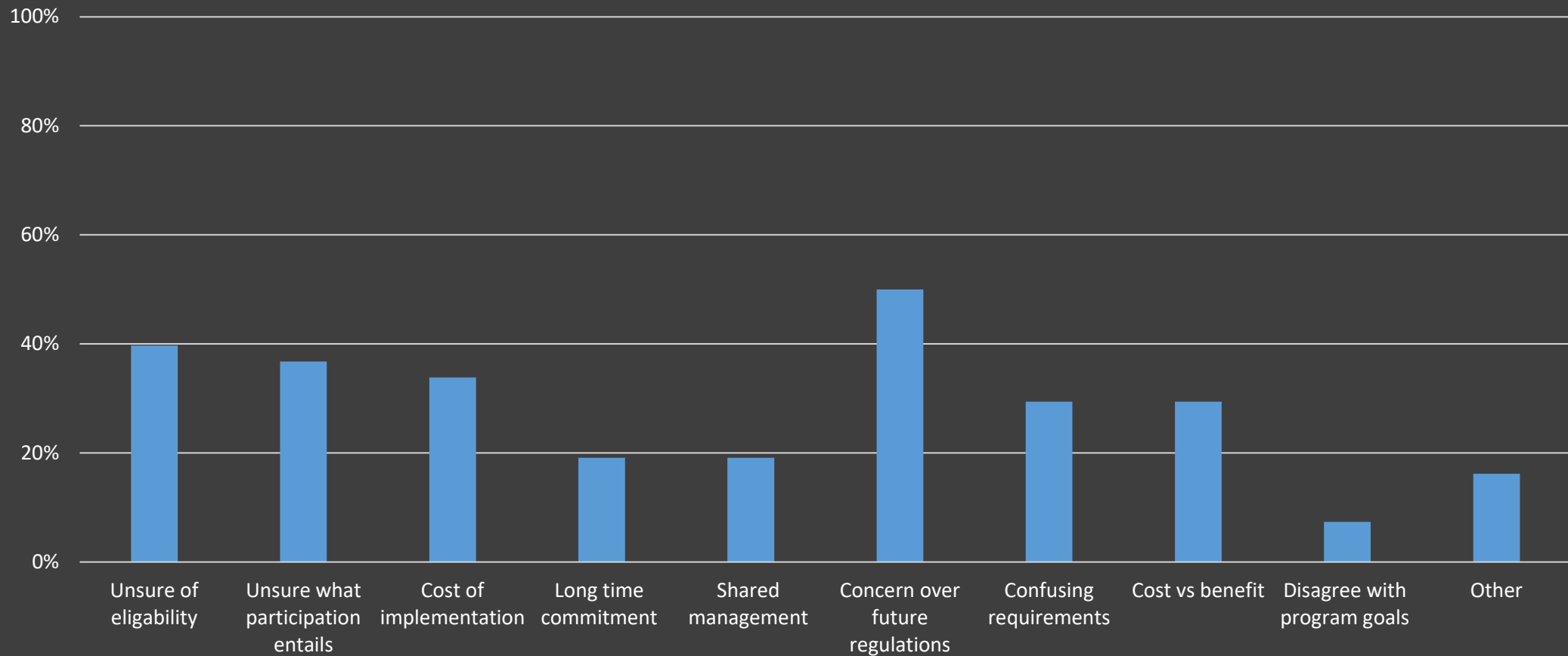
# Current incentives utilized and future interest: Timber
